

St. Paul Church Council met on Thursday, July 20<sup>th</sup>. Here are some highlights of the meeting:

- On the recommendation of the Finance Committee, Council voted to open a Thrivent MID CAP account for the purpose of investing our capitol project funds.
- A draft guideline for the Bereavement Committee is being reviewed.
- A request for use of the church grounds by Classical Conversations homeschool group.
- Work on the memorial cabinet is proceeding.
- Council voted to allow our FEMA insurance to expire.

A special meeting of the congregation was held on July 9<sup>th</sup>. The congregation approved proposed Project A: repair of the steeple and pillars and replacement of win-



dows and lighting. The congregation also approved Project B: establishment of a capital fund and capital campaign for replacement of the HVAC system.

In July the Piece Makers took a week off so that those working for VBS could decorate the Fellowship Hall to look like Babylon. As decorated for Babylon the Fellowship Hall really looks fantastic! You must drop in and view it. After VBS is over, we will enter Morgantown's hot month of August. 
